- 3. The proposed variable rate of \$1.7086 per m3 for water (\$1.5421 per m3 in 2023) and the proposed variable rate of \$1.5646 per m3 (\$1.3970 per m3 in 2023) for wastewater be approved.
- 4. The fixed rates for both water and wastewater as set out in the below table be approved:
