Cost: Residents \$61.00 / Non-Residents \$66.00

Advanced Swim Lessons: Daily Daytime

Ten (10) 1-hour lessons offered Monday - Friday in three 2-week sessions during July or August

Swim Levels Offered: Lifesaving Society Canadian Swim Patrol and Lifesaving Society Bronze Star.

Cost: Resident \$77.75 / Non-Resident \$84.00

Session 1: July 1 - 12 (Bronze Star – Niagara Pool)

Session 2: July 15 – 26 (Canadian Swim Patrol – St. Davids Pool)

Session 3: August 5 - August 16 (Bronze Star – St Davids Pool / Canadian Swim Patrol – Niagara Pool)





Private/Semi-Private Lessons: Daily Daytime

Five (5) 30-minute lessons offered at the same time Monday - Friday in a 1-week session during July and August.

Semi-private lessons can be done with friends and family within two swim levels of each other (up to three people).

Cost – Private Lesson: Resident \$147.90 (per participant) / Non-Resident \$159.75 (per participant) Cost – Semi-Private Lesson: Resident \$74.35 (per participant) / Non-Resident \$80.40 (per participant)

Cost: Residents \$48.80 / Non-Residents \$52.80

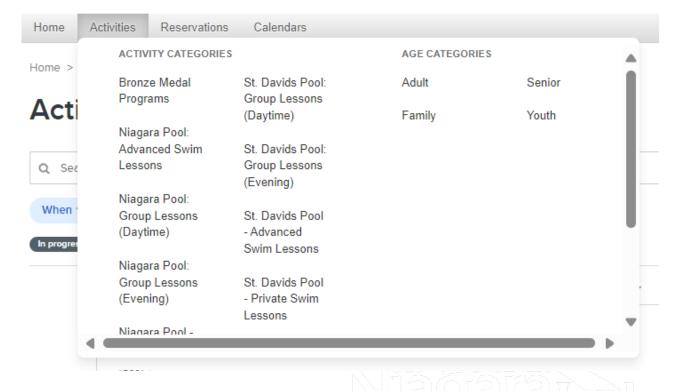
