## **BY-LAW NO. XXXX-25**

A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE DIRECTOR OF COMMUNITY AND DEVELOPMENT SERVICES TO EXECUTE ALL COVENENT AGREEMENTS BETWEEN THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF NIAGARA-ON-THE-LAKE AND REGISTERED PROPERTY OWNERS (Agreements to address the restoration of Ordnance Boundary Stones located on private property)

**WHEREAS** Section 37(1) of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter 0.18, authorizes the Council of a municipality to pass by-laws providing for the entering into easements or covenants with owners of real property; and

**WHEREAS** the reason for entering into the easements or covenants is for the conservation of the Ordnance Boundary Stones of cultural heritage value and interest to the Town; and

**WHEREAS** an Ordnance Boundary Stone Restoration Agreement has been developed;

**WHEREAS** it is deemed expedient to delegate authorization to the Director of Community and Development Services to approve these Agreements in perpetuity;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Niagara-on-the-Lake enacts as follows:

- 1. THAT the Director of Community and Development Services is hereby authorized to execute all Ordnance Boundary Stone Restoration Agreements between The Corporation of the Town of Niagara-on-the-Lake and Registered Property Owners regarding the restoration of Ordnance Boundary Stones located on private property; and
- 2. THAT the Lord Mayor and Clerk be authorized to affix their hands and the Corporate Seal; and
- 3. THAT this by-law shall come into force and take effect immediately upon the passing thereof.
