The Corporation of the Town of Niagara-on-the-Lake Proclaims May 9, 2025

"CANADIAN VIRAL HEPATITIS ELIMINATION DAY"

WHEREAS, hepatitis B and C are among Canada's most burdensome

infectious diseases, measured in liver damage, cancer, lives lost,

and significant costs to our public healthcare system; and

WHEREAS, more than 250,000 are living with hepatitis B, and more than

204,000 people in Canada are living with hepatitis C; and

WHEREAS, hepatitis B is vaccine preventable and treatable, and hepatitis C

is curable; and

WHEREAS, Canada has committed to eliminating viral hepatitis as a public

health threat by 2030; and

WHEREAS, Canadian Viral Hepatitis Elimination Day provides an

opportunity to highlight the need for policies that support easy access to testing, treatment, and care for those affected, paving

the way toward elimination; and

THEREFORE, be it resolved that I, Lord Mayor Gary Zalepa of The Corporation of the Town of Niagara-on-the-Lake, do hereby declare May 9, 2025, "2025 Canadian Viral Hepatitis Elimination Day" in the
