Region Commits to Niagara Stone Rd. Rehabilitation

- □ Niagara Region is reconstructing Niagara Stone Road in Niagara-on-the-Lake from Four Mile Creek Road to East / West Line to address:
 - Road capacity
 - Road conditions
 - ☐ Infrastructure improvements
 - □ Street scaping and urban design improvements
 - Overhead utility conversion to underground
- ☐ This project is in partnership with Niagara-on-the-Lake and Niagara-on-the-Lake Hydro.
- Businesses will stay open during construction. The contractor will minimize the potential impact to local businesses by limiting the work on the travelled portion of the road in July and August 2022, and July and August 2023.
- □ April 2023 Construction expected to be complete






Virgil Site in Need of Beautification
